President Donald Trump's economic adviser, Larry Kudlow, said on Sunday that Trump may meet Chinese President Xi Jinping(習近平) at G20 economic summit in Japan next month. He also said that he expects China to retaliate against the US for increasing tariffs on Chinese goods last week as Beijing has indicated it would. When asked whether US officials expect the Chinese to retaliate for the tariff hike put on by the US last week, "I think I do," said Kudlow. Kudlow admitted that China did not directly pay the tariffs imposed by the US, which was different from the president's saying that China would pay for it. American companies would pay tax increases, which are often passed on to consumers. But he added that "both sides will pay" because both nation's economies will feel some impact from the duties.
